CET syllabus and Test format for Full-time Diploma, Lateral Entry to Full-time Diploma, Advanced Diploma in Advanced Mechatronics (ADAM) and UG Program (B.A. Digital Media and Design)

1. The eligible candidate shall appear for the Entrance Test conducted by DSEU. The University will offer admissions through the merit list created on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in the Common Entrance Test/ Common Aptitude Test as stated below.
2. The Entrance Test will be conducted in **ONLINE AI Proctored mode, which the candidate can attempt from their home or any convenient location** but they will be required to have stable internet access so that he/she can attempt the exam in an uninterrupted manner. The Entrance Exam will be conducted **ONLY ONCE** as announced on the www.dseu.ac.in and DSEU admissions portal.
3. For the candidates seeking admission in the Engineering programs, the Merit list shall be created on the basis of marks obtained in sections A, B and C only. (Section C for Engineering)
4. For the candidates seeking admission in the Pharmacy program, the Merit list shall be created on the basis of marks obtained in sections A, B and D only. (Section D for Pharmacy)
5. For the candidates seeking admission in the Cosmetology & Health program, the Merit list shall be created on the basis of marks obtained in sections A, B and E only. (Section E for Cosmetology & Health)

Note:

- It is mandatory to qualify the respective sections of CET as per the criteria mentioned in the below table.
6. Candidates seeking to appear for CET in multiple streams (Eg. Engineering, Pharmacy, and Cosmetology & Health, or all of the above categories), will be required to appear for all the respective sections of the Common Entrance Test / Creative Aptitude Test/ ADAM Entrance Test/ Lateral Entry Entrance Test and their merit will be created separately for each category.
 7. **Candidates are required to secure either $\frac{1}{3}$ marks in each of the sections or 45% of the total marks.**

8. About various Entrance Tests

Note:

- All questions contain equal marks.
- There is NO negative marking.

Common Entrance Test (CET)

- Candidates appearing in CET for Engineering Diploma, Cosmetology & Health and Pharmacy will have to appear for Sections A, B, C, D and E as applicable. The total duration for these sections shall be 30 minutes for sections A and B each and 30 minutes each for sections C, D and E.
- Candidates appearing in more than one stream in CET will be required to appear for the common mandatory sections A and B and then the respective specialized sections at the given time slots. (Time of CET to be announced at a later stage on the University website).

Creative Aptitude Test (CAT)

- Candidates appearing in CAT for Design-based programs will have to appear for Sections A, B, and C. The total duration for these sections shall be 15 minutes for Section A, 10 minutes for Section B and 15 minutes for Section C.
- A separate Creative Aptitude Test shall be conducted for the candidates seeking admission to Creative and Design-based programs (Diploma in Architecture, Applied Arts, Art for Drawing Teacher, Interior Design, Fashion Design and Technology, Fashion Design, Textile Design and B.A. Digital Media and Design).
- The Creative Aptitude Test shall be conducted in 2 stages. The time for both tests shall be different. (Time of CET and Creative Aptitude Test to be announced at a later stage on the University website).
- Only those candidates who qualify in Stage: 1, Theory test shall be considered eligible for Stage: 2, Skill test. The skill test will be held offline at DSEU Campuses in Delhi.

ADAM Entrance test (ADAM-ET)

- Candidates appearing in ADAM Entrance test will have to appear for Sections A, B, C, D, E, F and G. The time duration for these sections shall be 10 minutes each.

Lateral Entry Entrance Test (LEET)

- Candidates appearing in Lateral Entry Entrance test for Lateral Entry to Full-time Diploma Programs will have to appear for Sections A and B. The total duration for these sections shall be 20 minutes each.

9. Cut-offs for all the aforementioned Entrance Tests are as follows:

Stage I- Theory test: Online, AI Proctored

- 30% (General Category candidate)
- 25% (Girls/ OBC/ EWS category candidate)
- 20% (SC/ST category candidate)

Stage II- Skill test, ((For Creative Aptitude Tests only)- Offline in DSEU campus (as applicable)

- 30% (General Category candidate)
- 25% (Girls/ OBC/ EWS category candidate)
- 20% (SC/ST category candidate)

Note:

- Merely appearing in the Entrance Test does not guarantee admission. Fulfillment of Minimum Eligibility Criteria as given in the Information Bulletin is a mandatory requirement and if a candidate does not fulfill the eligibility, despite giving the CET, they will not be considered for further processes of Merit and Counseling.
