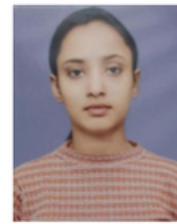

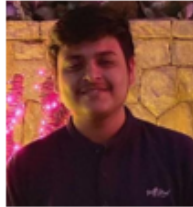

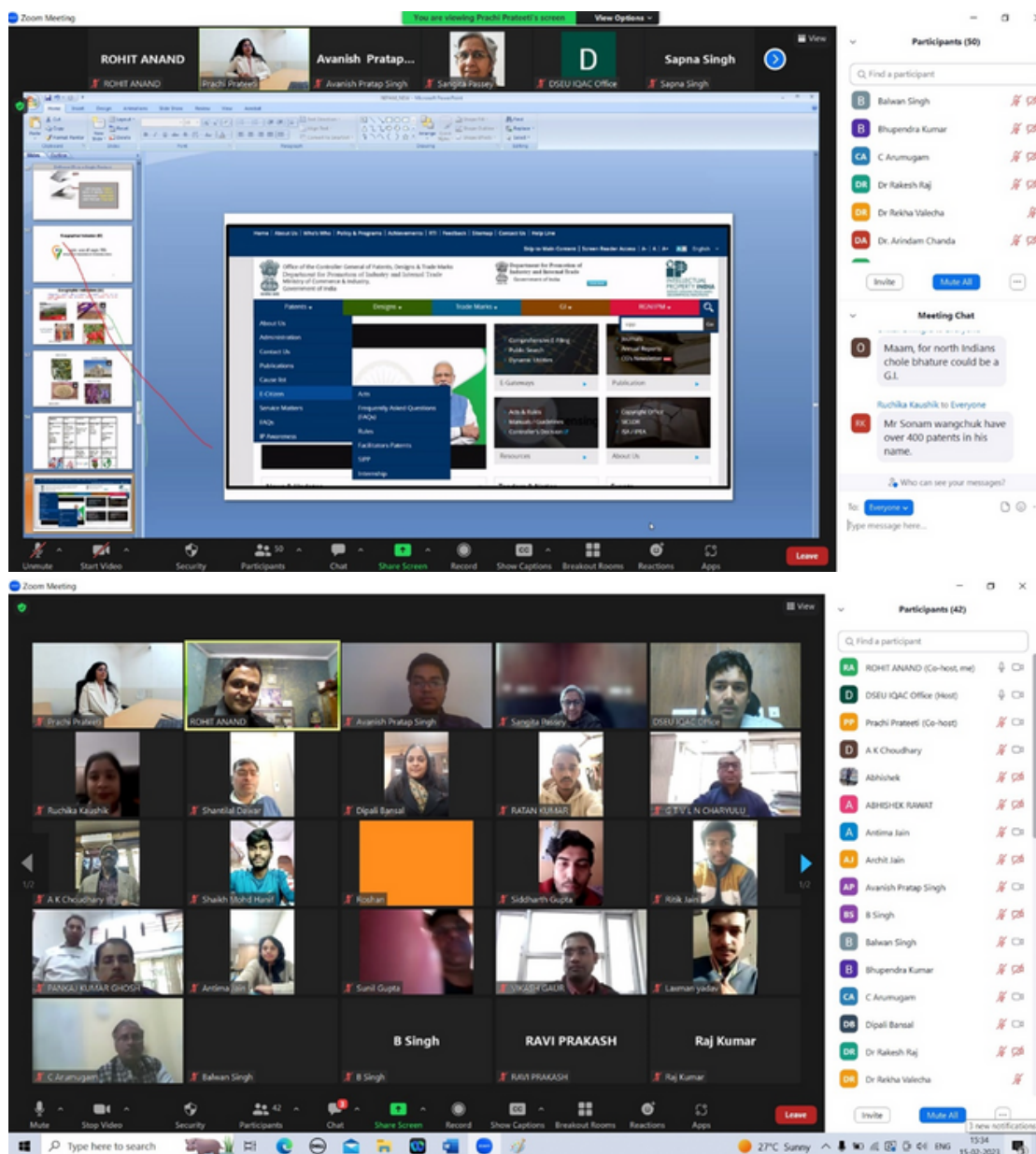

EXTERNAL RELATIONS AND COLLABORATIONS

- On February 15th, 2023, the IQAC Cell of DSEU and G.B. Pant DSEU Okhla-1 Campus collaborated with the office of the Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks to organize a webinar on 'Intellectual Property Rights.' The event was coordinated by Dr. Rohit Anand (Okhla-1 Campus) and Mr. Sahil Lohchab (DSEU). 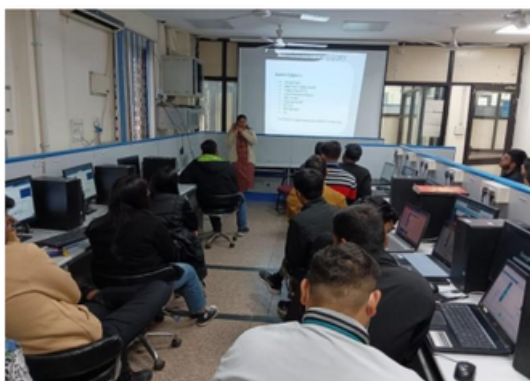
STUDENT ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS
