OFFICE ORDER

Promotion & Graduation Policy

for all Diploma and Degree DSEU -Students (except Diploma in Pharmacy)

This order supersedes Office Order F.No. 10(19)/DSEU/Acad/2021/183 dated 10.06.2022.

The guidelines mentioned below will be followed for promotion to second and further years. To be promoted to the next year of study the student will need to meet the minimum CGPA requirements specified below.

Programmes	Diploma	Degree	Post-Graduate
Min. CGPA	4.0	4.5	5.0

In addition the rules listed below will be followed for students having F Grades -

- 1 Students who are absent in all components of evaluation for a course shall be allotted 'F Grade'.
- 2 For promotion to next year, students can have a maximum of **two** F grades in all semesters completed till the end of that year.
- 3 Improvement of grades shall not be allowed for any course. However, if the student wants to improve grades, the student may appeal for a repeat year.
- 4 For some courses, students shall not receive a Letter Grade, only Pass or Fail shall be marked, such as courses like Sports & Yoga, etc. These courses are mandatory for students to pass to be eligible for the award of Diploma/Degree. They shall be marked as 'S' for Pass and 'X' for Fail. These courses shall not be counted in the maximum number of 'F' grades with which a student may be promoted to consecutive year. These courses shall not be included while calculation of CGPA for promotion/completion of degree. In case a student gets an X in such courses the student will have to take the responsibility of clearing the X by discussing with the Campus Director/Faculty in charge.

Graduation Rule: In accordance with clause 9.9.2 of the Student Handbook 2021-22 the guidelines mentioned below will be followed for award of Diploma/Degree.

1. To be eligible for the award of Degree/Diploma the student will need to meet the minimum CGPA requirements specified below.

In addition the rules listed below shall also apply:

2. A student shall be allowed to graduate the diploma/degree with a maximum **two** F grades. These two F grades can be of maximum 7 credits which could be maximum 3 credit in FTW (wherever applicable) and 4 credit in Foundation courses (wherever applicable). However, it is mandatory for the student to pass the minimum credits as required for the completion of Diploma/Degree. To complete the minimum required credits for the award of degree/diploma, the student can take additional electives in the subsequent semesters. Courses such as Sports & Yoga, etc. are mandatory for students to pass to be eligible for the award of Diploma/Degree.

As noted in the National Education Policy 2020, students shall have options of multiple entry and exit. This implies no limit on the maximum number of years for a student to complete the diploma/degree i.e. a student can graduate in N number of years. However, to retain his/her admission in the University, the student must pay 10% of the fees every year.

This order is applicable on all students of Academic Year 2021-2022 (except Diploma in Pharmacy) and all consecutive Academic Years (except Diploma in Pharmacy).


DSEU attaches great importance to the quality education for its students. The promotion policy for the students is accordingly designed, and it is in the interest of the students to maintain a good academic record through the duration of the program.
